## TripMaster Letter #5

March 4, 2017

This is more of a "WebMaster Letter" I guess, but it's a summary of last night's registration sprint.

Except for about a half dozen folks, everyone seemed to complete their registration satisfactorily. In the first hour we had 90 successful registrations! It tapered off this morning with 131.

To respond to any problem emails, and to assure that nobody got 'hung up' overnight, I was up until about 03:00 monitoring the registrations. Some of you had problems getting an email response from WhosComing, but that's a matter of each individual's email provider and setup -- not much we can do at that end. A few people did contact me and I provided needed info to get them going.

Most of you who were registering 'groups' followed my request and posted a "special message" to alert me that you wanted everyone in the same Group assignment; however, about a dozen or more people did not do that.

It took a lot longer than I anticipated (actually about 9 hours) today to sequence the registrations and get them assigned and grouped together into the three Premium Groups. I have checked the list and checked it twice, and I'm pretty sure that all families are grouped together even if they didn't ask

Needless to say, we had more than 75 registrations asking for Group #1 ... first, all the requests for Group #2 and Group #3 were assigned; then in the order of registration (according to WhosComing) each one was checked to see if there were others to be grouped with that name (as I assured everyone, if you registered one adult with a note of who else is in the group then the rest of the group registrations will be at the same sequence) and if there were they were assigned to Group #1 ... good thing it was 20F outside today, so I didn't mind being stuck inside doing this!
