Well - the big day is not far away now!

On-line registration IS CLOSED as of 1 a.m. Tuesday morning, and the registration info has been sent to the check-in team for Saturday morning's big operation of signing in over 250 folks.

Needless to say, there's going to be quite a crowd Saturday morning -- so please be considerate, stay in line and try to stay friendly while you wait to get signed in. And don't lose your door prize ticket once you get it!! (See door prize info, below).

If you have not yet registered on-line, you can still register Saturday morning [Buckwheat only] on-site for \$30, CASH. But expect your check-in to take longer than for those who are already registered and paid.

If you have registered on-line and used Credit Card or PayPal, please check to be sure you received a confirmation from paypal that the payment was made -- that way you can avoid a dispute over payments at the Saturday check-in.

Reminder that there will be appropriate types of safety glasses available for purchase on site, for \$4, if you do not already have them for yourself or your kids. (Those in the field digging, and those on the various tours, are REQUIRED to wear safety glasses).
